We live in culture-based communities — so first and foremost we need recognizable **Personal Verbal Communication Skills** => Speech + Pantomime + Punctuation that can only be assimilated Post-Puberty.

Post-Puberty the full right-side of our Cerebral Cortex comes on-line and we Humans can *intellectually* begin to handle impersonal relationships + mental gymnastics + a range of Considerations, Perspectives and Behaviors. Personal Communication is the most important.

Verbal Communication Skills with Pantomime Punctuation

1. How-to Make Speech Sounds: The English language contains 44 distinct speech sounds, called *Phonemes*. These are divided into about 24 consonant sounds and 20 vowel sounds.
2. Hear the Sounds of English
3. Modulated delivery: Tone + Pitch + Volume + Accent?
4. Speaking Rate: 120 – 160 wpm
5. Miming Tics and Tells: 12+ facial expressions + body language + physical position
6. Listening: mentally framing the speaker's purpose of the proposed Content (*before discussion starts*)
7. Comprehending: Context-of-Content
8. Categorizing: Relativity to your World
9. Prioritizing: significance: Fact + Science + Reality + Cultural Inferences
10. Speech Vocabulary: 6,000 Words (*"conversationally fluent" level*)
11. Reading Rate: 360 – 480 wpm
Faster reading speeds = better comprehension.
12. Reading Vocabulary: 9,000 Words (Minimum needed to read a novel.)
13. Verbal Sourcing => Collaboration.
The only thing less effective than attending Lectures is watching Videos of Lectures.
14. Reference Sourcing: Google + Blinkist (*use written summaries only*)
15. Retention Rate: Notes in the Margin can boost to 90%
16. Posture: Indicates level of attention
17. Physical Appearance: indicates level of Capabilities + Competencies + Perspectives
18. Dress: indicates level of Interest
